

Lesson Plan: Farm Animals

Target Level: Beginner

Materials needed: Flashcards

<i>Time</i>	<i>Stage</i>	<i>Target Language</i>	<i>Activity</i>
1-3 min.	Warm up/Review Review familiar vocabulary from previous lessons to warm students up		Recap previous lesson with charades Sing 'Old MacDonald Had a Farm'
15-20 min.	Process:		
5-10 min.	Intro Introduce the topic and new vocabulary in the simplest form	-Dog -Cat -Duck -Cow -Pig -Sheep -Frog	Place animal flashcards around room and play animal noises. Ask students to point at correct animal. Walk around classroom to flashcards, pronouncing words and doing actions, asking students to repeat Stand at front of class and do actions, students say correct word
5-7 min.	Context Introduce the target sentence to put vocab in context	'What is it?' 'It is a...'	Stand students in a circle, pass a flashcard and ask, 'what is it?' Students answer + repeat question and answer around the circle
5-10 min.	Practice A topic based task for students to practice language		One student from each team stands Teacher shows picture of animal and asks, 'what is it?' First to answer gets team points
3-5 min.	Assessment Test understanding of the class as a whole		Charades: Ask a volunteer to come to front of class and perform action. Students must raise hands to answer, 'It is a...'. Award team points
3-5 min.	Cool Down A fun, calming activity to wrap up lesson. Reward good behaviour.		Flashcard recap, Watch farm video; https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=go8HZ9vrmOo
