

Lesson Plan: Clothes

Target Level: Beginner

Materials needed: Clothes items or flashcards

Song: Clothing song; https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=taoCF1cKZSY

Time	Stage	Target Language	Activity
1-3 min.	Warm up/Review Review familiar vocabulary from previous lessons to warm students up		Review words from last lesson using Pictionary; draw a word from last lesson and students must guess what it is the word.
15-20 min.	Process:		
5-10 min.	Intro Introduce the topic and new vocabulary in the simplest form	-t shirt -skirt -dress -trousers -hat -jacket -shorts	Begin with a song introducing the topic, https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=taoCF1cKZSY&t=1s Introduce the new vocabulary with pictures on PowerPoint slides and/or a real item of clothing. Ask the students to repeat it to perfect pronunciation.
5-7 min.	Context Introduce the target sentence to put vocab in context	I'm wearing	Play the "What are you wearing?" video; https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=h6CvRv-AH2Y What are you wearing? Go through each item of clothing and ask the class, "Who is wearing a T-shirt?" Students wearing a T-shirt should stand up and chant together "I'm wearing a T-shirt" Repeat for each item of clothing. Differentiation: Some students will be wearing other items of clothing e.g. tights/leggings. Teach these words as extra vocab.
5-10 min.	Practice A topic based task for students to practice language	At shirt -skirt -dress -trousers -hat -jacket -shorts	Show various images of characters wearing various clothes. Ask the class; 'What can you see?' 'What clothes can you see?' 'What is the wearing?'

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3-5	Assessment	Drawing clothes game: Draw a girl/boy on the board
