

Lesson Plan: Emotions **Target Level:** Beginner +

Materials needed: Slips of paper

Time	Stage	Target Language	Activity
1-3 min. 15-20 min.	Warm up/Review Review familiar vocabulary from previous lessons to warm students up Process:		Use the 'whack game' to recap vocab; ask two students to come to the front and touch the picture of the word you say
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5-10 min.	Intro Introduce the topic and	-Happy -Unhappy	Sing 'If You're Happy' song
	new vocabulary in the simplest form	-Sad -Angry -Scared	Intro vocab using facial expressions and a drawing on the board
		-Tired	Ask students to copy expression and repeat word
5-7 min.	Context Introduce the target sentence to put vocab in context	'How do you feel?' 'I feel'	Ask students to draw an emotion on a slip of paper. Go around the class asking students 'How do you feel?'. They must answer using I feel + the emotion they have drawn. Ask them to hold up to check their answer.
5-10 min.	Practice A topic based task for students to practice language		Charades: ask two students at a time to come to front of classroom. Give them an emotion to act out and their teammates must guess what it is using 'I feel'
2 F main	Accomment		Award points to fastest team
3-5 min.	Assessment Test understanding of the class as a whole		Who Came to the Party? Ask one student to leave the room. Give remaining students an emotion to act out. Ask student to come back in the room and guess what emotion the class is feeling
3-5 min.	Cool Down A fun, calming activity to wrap up lesson. Reward good behaviour.		Recap vocab by saying 'I feel' and students act out emotion Sing 'If You're Happy' song
